



# **Current status of project**

- The project is being delivered in stages, with different stages being progressively completed over approximately six years (October 2028 is the scheduled opening date)
- Early Works completed for Arts Centre Melbourne upgrades
- Lendlease announced as contractor for Main Works for Arts Centre Melbourne
- Early works for NGV have begun about to select a contractor for deconstruction of 77 Southbank Boulevard
- Schematic Design for Public Realm and The Fox: NGV Contemporary nearly complete
- Early works for The Fox: NGV Contemporary are expected to commence in 2024.
